Victoria Gonzalez, the reigning 2019 Miss Fiesta, has partnered with Communities In Schools of San Antonio (CIS-SA) for her signature community service project with a goal to provide 2,000 hygiene kits to middle school students. CIS-SA is an affiliate of the nation's largest, most effective drop-out prevention program in which CIS Site Coordinators work inside schools to provide what a student needs in order to stay in school.

In 2015, Victoria served as a Bank of America Student Leader at CIS-SA, where she learned the needs of our students first-hand. Oftentimes, students who do not have access to the necessary hygiene products will skip school because they are embarrassed of their body odor or appearance and want to avoid bullying. Providing middle school students with a **Boost Box**, filled with hygiene products, will give these students the **boost of confidence** they need to go to school each day.

The **Boost Box** will have its own fresh design to mimic a hygiene kit without students having to be embarrassed to take it home. Boost Boxes will be delivered to 23 CIS-SA middle schools throughout San Antonio and will be available for other CIS-SA students to promote healthy habits, overall wellness, and self confidence.
