Professor, Johns Hopkins School of Public Health

Dr. Makary is a professor of health policy at the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health and a professor of surgery at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Dr. Makary has served in leadership roles at the World Health Organization and has published over 250 scientific research articles on health care quality, payment reform, and the appropriateness of medical care.

Dr. Makary is a member of the National Academy of Medicine and an expert on public health policy, health care transparency and vulnerable populations. He is the editor-in-chief of Medpage Today and is a Fox News medical contributor. Dr. Makary writes for *The Wall Street Journal*, *USA Today*, and is *The New York Times* bestselling author of three books including *The Price We Pay* which was named 2019 business book of the year.
